

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

EVEREST WEALTH - SPCA GIVING BACK — DONATION DRIVE & APPRECIATION DRAW

IMPORTANT NOTICE

These Terms and Conditions govern the donation appreciation draw ("the Draw") conducted by Everest Wealth Management (Pty) Ltd ("the Organiser") in connection with the SPCA Giving Back — Donation Drive initiative.

The Draw is a donation appreciation gesture and does not constitute a promotional competition as defined in the Consumer Protection Act, 68 of 2008 ("CPA"). Participation in the Draw is open only to persons who make a qualifying physical donation as set out in these Terms and Conditions.

By making a donation and participating in the Draw, all participants ("Donors") agree to be fully and unconditionally bound by these Terms and Conditions.

These Terms and Conditions will be available on the Organiser's website (www.everestwealth.co.za) for the duration of the initiative.

This Draw is conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Protection of Personal Information Act, 4 of 2013 ("POPIA").

Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully before participating.

PART 1: DRAW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Organiser

This donation appreciation draw ("the Draw") is organised by Everest Wealth Management (Pty) Ltd (Registration Number: 2002/004025/07), an authorised Financial Services Provider (FSP Number: 795, CAT I & II, & IIA) and registered credit provider NCRCP 21504 ("the Organiser").

2. Initiative Name and Description

The initiative is known as the Everest Wealth 'SPCA Giving Back — Donation Drive & Appreciation Draw' ("the Initiative").

The Draw is conducted as a gesture of appreciation to donors who contribute to the SPCA Giving Back initiative. It is not a promotional competition and does not offer a prize in exchange for entry. Participation in the Draw is a consequence of making a qualifying donation and is not the primary purpose of the donation.

This Initiative is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with the SPCA, Meta Platforms, Inc. (Facebook or Instagram), or any other third-party platform or organisation, unless expressly stated. By participating, Donors release all such third parties from any liability in connection with this Initiative.

3. Initiative Period

The Initiative opens on **01 June 2026** ("the Opening Date") and closes on **17 July 2026** at 17:00 (SAST) ("the Closing Date").

Donations received after the Closing Date and time will not be eligible for the Draw.

The Draw recipient will be announced on **25 July 2026** at the **Cuddle, Play & Adoption Day Event** @Waltloo SPCA Centre, Tshwane SPCA, 316 Petroleum St, Silverton, Pretoria, 0127 [or such other date/platform as communicated by the Organiser].

The Organiser reserves the right to extend, shorten, or cancel the Initiative at its sole discretion, provided such changes are communicated publicly via the Organiser's social media platforms and website.

4. Eligibility

- a. The Draw is open to all natural persons who are residents of the Republic of South Africa, aged 16 years or older, and in possession of a valid South African identity document, who make a qualifying physical donation as set out in Clause 5.
- b. The Draw is not open to any person who is a director, employee, or consultant to the Organiser (Everest Wealth Management (Pty) Ltd).

5. Qualifying Donations and Draw Participation

The Draw is a donation appreciation gesture. Participation is available to Donors who make a qualifying physical donation at any designated drop-off point listed in Schedule 1 to these Terms and Conditions, or at the Organiser's offices, during the Initiative Period.

Qualifying donation items include:

- i. Pet food
- ii. Blankets and towels
- iii. Cleaning supplies
- iv. Toys and treats
- v. Food
- vi. Any other item that may assist the SPCA and the animals in their care

Monetary contributions may also be made directly to the SPCA. Proof of monetary contribution presented at a drop-off point or to the Organiser will qualify the donor for the Draw.

- a. Upon making a qualifying donation, Donors must provide their full name and a valid contact number or email address to be included in the Draw. No entry form or further action is required.
- b. Only one (1) Draw participation per person is permitted, regardless of the number or value of donations made. Multiple donations by the same person will not increase their chances of selection.
- c. The Organiser accepts no responsibility for donor details that are incomplete, illegible, or not successfully recorded due to error or any other reason.
- d. Making a donation is entirely voluntary. The Draw is offered as an expression of appreciation and does not constitute consideration or an inducement to donate.

6. The Hamper

- a. One (1) Draw recipient will be selected.
- b. The selected recipient will receive one (1) appreciation hamper ("the Hamper"). The estimated total value of the Hamper is **R6 327.00**. The contents of the Hamper will be confirmed and published on the Organiser's social media platforms prior to the Closing Date. This will be on the Event Day of 25 July 2026 @Waltloo SPCA Centre
- c. The Hamper is not transferable, not exchangeable for cash, and cannot be sold or substituted by the recipient.
- d. The Organiser reserves the right to substitute the Hamper with an alternative of equal or greater value should circumstances require.
- e. Any additional costs not explicitly stated herein will be for the recipient's own account.

7. Recipient Selection and Notification

- a. The Draw recipient will be selected by means of a random selection conducted from all eligible donor entries recorded by the Closing Date.
- b. The selection will take place on 25 July 2026
- c. The selection will be overseen by an independent third party to ensure fairness and transparency.
- d. The selected recipient will be notified via the contact details provided at the time of donation (email or phone). The Organiser will make reasonable attempts to contact the recipient.
- e. The selected recipient must respond to the notification within forty-eight (48) hours and provide the following verification details via secure email only: Full Name, ID Number, residential address, and contact number.

- f. If a recipient fails to respond within the 48-hour period, is found to be ineligible, or fails to provide the required information, they will be disqualified and will forfeit the Hamper. The Organiser reserves the right to select an alternate recipient in such an event.
- g. The Organiser's decision regarding the selected recipient is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into.

8. Hamper Acceptance

- a. To accept the Hamper, the recipient must confirm acceptance within forty-eight (48) hours of notification and supply the verification details set out in Clause 7(e).
- b. Arrangements for Hamper collection or delivery will be confirmed with the recipient directly.
- c. Should the recipient fail to comply with these conditions, they will forfeit the Hamper and the Organiser reserves the right to select an alternate recipient.

9. Publicity and Marketing

- a. The Organiser reserves the right to announce the recipient's first name and province of residence for transparency purposes.
- b. The recipient has the right to decline participation in any additional promotional or marketing activities. Declining will not result in forfeiture or any reduction of the Hamper value.
- c. No photography or filming of the recipient is required as a condition of receiving or enjoying the Hamper.

10. Donations

- a. All donations received in connection with this Initiative are accepted in good faith and are non-refundable.
- b. Everest Wealth Management (Pty) Ltd acts as a collection facilitator for purposes of this Initiative and does not operate as a registered public benefit organisation (PBO).
- c. Donations made through this Initiative are not tax-deductible under Section 18A of the Income Tax Act, 58 of 1962, unless otherwise confirmed in writing by the Organiser. Donors are advised to confirm the tax status of their donation directly with the SPCA where donations are made to the SPCA.
- d. The Draw is offered purely as an appreciation gesture. The value or nature of a donation does not affect the random selection process. Each eligible donor has one equal chance of being selected regardless of the size or value of their donation.

11. Adoption Day Event


- a. The Adoption Day Event is subject to change, postponement, or cancellation at the Organiser's discretion. Reasonable notice will be provided via the Organiser's social media platforms and website.
- b. All attendees participate in the Adoption Day Event at their own risk. The Organiser accepts no liability for any loss, injury, or damage sustained at or in connection with the event.
- c. Animal adoptions facilitated at or in connection with the event are subject to the SPCA's own adoption criteria, policies, and processes, which are entirely within the SPCA's sole discretion. Everest Wealth Management (Pty) Ltd does not act as agent for the SPCA in respect of any adoption and accepts no liability in connection therewith.

12. General Conditions

- a. The Organiser reserves the right to amend, suspend, or cancel the Initiative or these Terms and Conditions if circumstances arise beyond its reasonable control, provided such changes are communicated publicly.
- b. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any participant who, in its reasonable opinion, has violated these Terms and Conditions, provided false information, or acted fraudulently.
- c. The Organiser's decision in all matters related to the Draw shall be final and binding.
- d. This Initiative does not constitute financial advice, nor does participation create a client relationship with Everest Wealth Management (Pty) Ltd.

13. Limitation of Liability

- a. To the fullest extent permitted by law, by participating in the Draw, Donors agree that the Organiser (Everest Wealth Management (Pty) Ltd), its affiliates, holding companies, subsidiaries,



employees, and agents shall not be liable for any loss, damage, injury, or claim (including direct, indirect, or consequential loss) arising from or connected to participation in this Initiative or the acceptance, use, or misuse of the Hamper.

- b. The Organiser accepts no responsibility for technical failures, communication errors, or other problems beyond its control that may affect donor registration or recipient notification.

14. Data Protection (POPIA)

- a. Personal information collected through this Initiative (e.g., names, contact numbers, email addresses) will be processed in accordance with the Protection of Personal Information Act, 4 of 2013 (POPIA).
- b. The Organiser will use such data solely for the purposes of: (a) administering the Draw; (b) verifying donor eligibility; (c) contacting the selected recipient; and (d) as otherwise required by law.
- c. Personal information will not be shared with third parties without consent, except as required by law or for the administration of this Initiative.
- d. Donors have the right to request access to or correction of their personal information by contacting info@everestwealth.co.za.
- e. By participating, Donors consent to the processing of their personal information as described in these Terms and Conditions.

15. Legal Jurisdiction

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of South Africa.

Any disputes arising from or related to this Initiative shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the South African courts.
